Cart Placement

Dispose of your garbage and yard waste in the waste cart provided by Republic Services, and your recyclables in the recycling cart.

Make sure the lid is closed, without packing your garbage too tightly. Waste and recycling carts are the property of Republic Services and are assigned to your street address. Please do not remove carts from address.



For collection, place the container as close as possible to the curb or roadside, **NOT** on the street.

Make sure the container is at least 3 feet from mailboxes, parked cars, trees, light posts and the handle and lid hinge is facing your residence.

Please ensure the lid is closed to prevent damage to the 96-gallon carts.

Helpful Hints

- 1. Any plastic beverage container is recyclable
- 2. All colors of plastic and glass are acceptable
- 3. Bottle caps are recyclable, even on the bottle
- 4. Any black trash found in the recycling will be thrown away. Excess recycling can be placed in clear plastic bags or cardboard boxes.

The Shelby County Recycling Center accepts many of the materials we are unable to, including electronics and yard waste!

Glass


Clear, brown and green beverage containers (soda, beer, wine and liquor bottles) and food containers (pickle/ketchup/jelly/etc)

Electronics

Some Paper Products and Yard Waste
