Commissioner McDowell (Road) – No Report

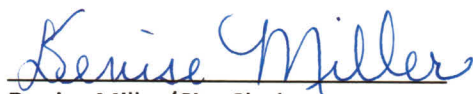
Commissioner Vowels (Police) – No Report
