Commissioner Hesse (Sewer) – No Report

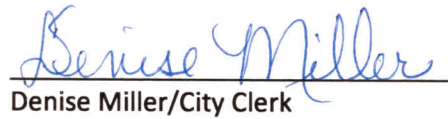
Commissioner McDowell (Road) – No Report
