Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report:

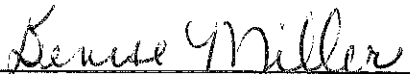

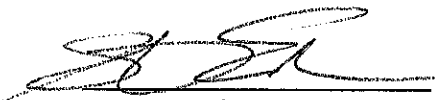
