Commissioner Vowels (Police) –

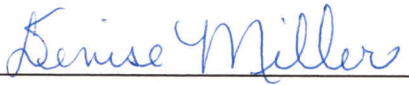

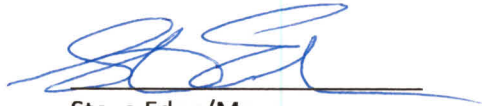
Commissioner Garland (Finance) –
