Commissioner Hesse (Sewer) – No Report

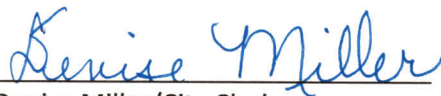
Commissioner McDowell (Road) –

Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

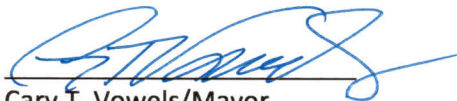
Commissioner Eden (Finance) –
