Mayor Vowels called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Vowels presented, for approval, the minutes from February 19, 2019 regular meeting. After review, **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept minutes as presented. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Vowels recognized the City Attorney's Report:

City Attorney Hays presented to the Commission, for approval, Ordinance #2019-001 pertaining to the Interlocal Agreement on Tourism's Transient Tax. City Attorney Hays read the ordinance in its entirety. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept Ordinance #2019-001 for the first reading. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Ordinance #2019-001 will be placed on the March 19, 2019 meeting agenda for the second reading and possible adoption.**

City Clerk Miller reported 15 property tax bills remain delinquent, 1 from 2017 and 14 from 2018, totaling \$4,442.25.

Commissioner McDowell (Road) –

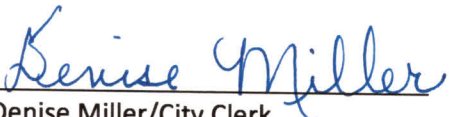
