Mayor Vowels called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Vowels presented, for approval, the minutes from December 15, 2020 city meeting. After review, **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept minutes as presented. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Commissioner McDowell (Road) –

Commissioner McDowell presented to the Commission, for approval, the recommendation to proceed with a Sidewalk Trip Hazard Removal Phase IV Proposal from Precision Concrete Cutting, not to exceed \$4,181.25. The City applied for and was awarded a matching grant from KLC, therefore, \$1,500 will be applied to the cost. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to approve the Sidewalk Trip Hazard Removal Phase IV Proposal of \$4,181.25 from Precision Concrete Cutting and to authorize the Mayor to sign the authorization to proceed. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Vowels recognized the City Attorney's Report:

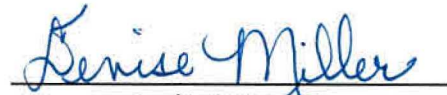
City Attorney Hays reported he had filed the small claims case.
