Mayor Pro-Tem McDowell recognized the City Attorney's Report: No Report

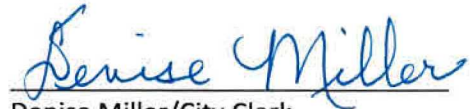
Mayor Pro-Tem McDowell recognized the City Administrator:

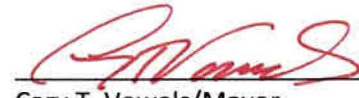
