REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Vowels called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Pledge

Mayor Vowels presented, for approval, the minutes from July 5, 2022 city meeting. After review, **Commissioner McDowell made the motion to accept minutes as presented. Commissioner Hesse seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Commissioner Garland (Police/Parks) -

Commissioner Garland presented to the Commission, on behalf of PW/Park Director Truelock, for consideration, a quote from Earth Planter for \$6,839.00 to purchase additional hanging planters and new sidewalk planters for next season. Commissioner Emmons read the 2021-2022 budget changes. **Commissioner McDowell made the motion to accept Ordinance #2022-004 for the first reading. Commissioner Hesse seconded. Ordinance #2022-004 will be placed on the August 1, 2022 meeting agenda for the second reading and possible adoption.**

Mayor Vowels presented to the Commission, for approval, the recommendation to reappoint Joey Budd as the City's Representative on the Triple S Board of Adjustments & Appeals for the term beginning May 1, 2022, ending April 30, 2026. **Commissioner Garland made the motion to reappoint Joey Budd as the City of Simpsonville's Representative on the Triple S Board of Adjustments & Appeals with term expiring April 30,2026.
