

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
JULY 2, 2015 6:30 PM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Hesse, and Vowels. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, Sergeant Hurt, and City Clerk Batliner. Guests: Police Officer Daniel Wills with several family members, and Carrie Crotzer/Sentinel News.

Absent: Commissioners Cummins and Garland.

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Pledge.

The Oath of Office for Police Officer Daniel Wills was administered by Mayor Eden.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from June 18, 2015 regular City Meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized the Commissioner's Report:

Commissioner Hesse advised the new effluent line is operational and had pumped 2 ½ million gallons in 3 days.

Commissioner Cummins-Absent. City Administrator Eaton advised repairs on Cardinal Drive and Spring Street have been completed.

Commissioner Vowels had nothing at this time.

Commissioner Garland-Absent.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Attorney's Report: City Attorney Hays had nothing at this time.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton advised the new trees have been planted along the sidewalks and gave an update on the traffic signal going in at Todds Pointe Road and Shelbyville Road. City Administrator Eaton presented:

- Change order (1) pertaining to the Effluent Line project for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. City Administrator Eaton explained change order (1). **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept change order (1) with the additional cost of \$9,200.00. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
- A total of (7) change orders in the amount of \$32,770.55 pertaining to the sidewalk project for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. City Administrator Eaton explained each change order. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the change orders. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

- A pay request from Pace Contracting in the amount of \$213,110.05 pertaining to the sidewalk project for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the pay request as presented. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
- A pay request from the Derrick Engineering for the Cardinal Club Effluent line project in the amount of \$5,869.24 for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the pay request as presented. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
- A pay request from JODA International for the Cardinal Club Effluent line project in the amount of \$188,765.00 for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the pay request as presented. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized Police Sergeant Hurt: Simpsonville Police Sergeant Hurt advised the Police Department passed all 161 standards on the accreditation evaluation and that an official certificate will be received at the Chief of Police Banquet, August 5, 2015.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Clerk's Report: City Clerk Batliner advised payroll has been transitioned.

Commissioner Vowels made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Hesse seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting concluded approximately 7:12 pm.
