

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
JULY 7, 2016 7:30 PM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Cummins, Garland, Hesse, and Vowels. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, and City Clerk Batliner. Guest: Sentinel News.

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Pledge.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from June 16, 2016 regular city meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Cummins seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden presented Ordinance #2016-007 pertaining to Impounding Vehicles for the second reading and possible adoption and everyone was furnished a copy. City Attorney Hays read Ordinance # 2016-007. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the second reading and adoption of Ordinance # 2016-007. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** A roll call is as follows:

Ordinance #2016-007 will become effective upon publication in the Sentinel News.

Mayor Eden presented a proposal from the Auditor for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the proposal from Blue & Co. LLC and authorized the Mayor to sign the contract for the audit services. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized the Commissioner's Report:

Commissioner Hesse had nothing at this time. Mayor Eden stated that the effluent line to the Cardinal Club has pumped 50 million gallons over the last year, and the pumping is going well.

Commissioner Cummins had nothing at this time.

Commissioner Vowels had nothing at this time.

Commissioner Garland advised bids for the repaving project will be advertised next week. At the August 18, 2016 Meeting AEI will present their recommendation for the project.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Attorney's Report: City Attorney Hays advised the Fiber Franchise Notice will be advertised next Wednesday in the Sentinel News. Also, City Attorney Hays presented a letter of resignation from Officer Terry Putnam. **Commissioner Cummins made the motion to accept the resignation from Officer Putnam. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton advised:

- CCG-Louisville has requested consent from the Commission to set off fireworks on July 29, 2016. **Commissioner Cummins made the motion to approve the request. Commissioner Garland seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
- Officer Wills has left, Police Chief Minnis has been interviewing for the vacant position.
- Simpsonville Parks Department had to reschedule the July 4th Fireworks show for July 8, 9, or 10 and requested approval from Commission for a waiver do to the Fireworks Ordinance. **Commissioner Garland made the motion to approve the waiver. Commissioner Cummins seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
- The Shelby County Horse Show Breakfast is July 28, 2016 at 7:30 am.

Mayor Eden advised the KLC Conference is in Lexington October 4-7. Please advise City Clerk Batliner if you are able to attend so she can complete the registration.

Commissioner Vowels made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Cummins seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting concluded approximately 7:55 pm.
