

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
SPECIAL CALLED CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
JUNE 7, 2016 7:30 PM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Cummins, Hesse, Garland, and Vowels. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, and City Clerk Batliner. Guests: Sentinel News and Charles Hogg.

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from May 19, 2016 regular city meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the minutes as presented with the spelling of two words on page 2. Commissioner Cummins seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden presented Ordinance # 2016-005 pertaining to the Budget Amendment for first reading and everyone was furnished a copy. City Clerk Batliner read Ordinance #2016-005. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept first reading of Ordinance #2016-005 pertaining to the Budget Amendment. Commissioner Vowels seconded.** Ordinance #2016-005 will be placed on the June 16, 2016 Regular City Meeting Agenda for second reading and possible adoption.

Mayor Eden presented Ordinance # 2016-006 pertaining to Broadband for first reading and everyone was furnished a copy. City Attorney Hays read the Ordinance #2016-006 Summary. **Commissioner Cummins made the motion to accept first reading on Ordinance #2016-006. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Ordinance # 2016-006 will be placed on the June 16, 2016 Regular City Meeting Agenda for second reading and possible adoption.

Mayor Eden advised he and City Administrator Eaton met with Building Inspector Barry Edington to discuss a Building Inspection Program at the cost of \$3,000.00 and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the Building Inspection Program quote from iWorQ. Commissioner Cummins seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized the Commissioner's Report:

Commissioner Cummins advised:

- Officer Daniel Wills will be resigning.
- 34 seat citations were issued during the Click It or Ticket It Campaign.
- In August there will be a Drive Sober or Get Pulled over Campaign.

Commissioner Vowels had nothing at this time.

Commissioner Hesse had nothing at this time.

Commissioner Garland advised he had a good meeting with the engineers and bond counsel pertaining to the paving project. Bids will be in August.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Attorney's Report: City Attorney Hays had nothing at this time.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton advised Champions Way repair has been finished.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Clerk's Report: City Clerk Batliner advised there are a total of 4 delinquent properties for all years, 1 property is a foreclosure, 1 property is involved in probate, and 2 properties are 2015 delinquents only. City Attorney Hays is assisting with liens on those properties.

Commissioner Cummins made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Vowels seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting concluded approximately 7:51pm.
