REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Garland, Hesse, and McDowell. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal counsel, City Administrator Eaton, and City Clerk Batliner. Guests:

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Pledge

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from February 2, 2017 regular City Meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Eden presented a donation request from the Human Rights Commission for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. Mayor Eden stated that Shelby County Fiscal Court and the City of Shelbyville had made a donation of \$250.00 each. **Commissioner McDowell made the motion to donate \$250.00 to the Human Rights Commission for printing and office supplies. Commissioner Hesse seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Eden presented a Proclamation declaring May Building Safety Month. Mayor Eden read the proclamation in its entirety. **Commissioner Garland made the motion to accept the Building Safety Month Proclamation. Commissioner Hesse seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Eden recognized the Commissioner's Reports:

Commissioner Hesse presented a change order from Twin States Utilities & Excavation, Inc. for the 8" Sewer Line Replacement Project in the amount of \$1,065.50 for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to approve the change order in the amount of \$1,065.50 from Twin States Utilities & Excavation, Inc. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Commissioner Garland presented the financial reports for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to accept the financial report as presented. Commissioner McDowell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Eden recognized the City Attorney's Report: City Attorney Hays had nothing at this time.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton reported the following:

1. Bids are due on March 3, 2016 at 1:00 pm for the storage facility.
2. The Parks Shelter Project is progressing well.
3. All the easements have been secured for Phase III of the sidewalk project. The easements have been submitted to the state for approval.

Mayor Eden addressed the Commission on the state of the City. Mayor Eden commented that the Legislative Body has always worked together for the good of the City and looks forward to that continuing in the future. Mayor Eden also stated that the City as a whole is in great shape. Mayor Eden complimented the new Judge Executive Ison on his efforts to work with all governmental bodies of the county and excited to continue the working relationship with the 911 Board Agreement.
