Commissioner Vowels had nothing at this time.

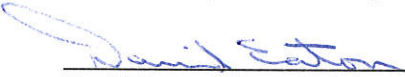
Commissioner Garland reported on preliminary work to pave all the streets in Simpsonville. Also, reported that we are getting an estimate for small repairs on Champions Way.
