

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
NOVEMBER 19, 2014 8:30 AM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Cummins, Hesse, and Vowels. City Attorney's Hays and Brammell were in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, Public Works Director Romine, and Parks Director Truelock. Guests: Sentinel News/ Todd Martin.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from November 4, 2014 for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Vowels made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Hesse seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eden recognized the Commissioner's Report:
