

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
OCTOBER 20, 2010 8:30 AM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners Cummins, and McDowell. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, Police Chief Chappell, and City Clerk Batliner. Guests: Fire Chief Jones and Steve Doyle/Sentinel News.

Absent: Commissioner Vowels, Commissioner Wise, and Public Works Director Romine

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from October 5, 2010 regular meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner McDowell made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Cummins seconded.** Motion carried unanimously.
