Mayor Vowels called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

City Clerk Miller offered an update regarding delinquent property taxes:

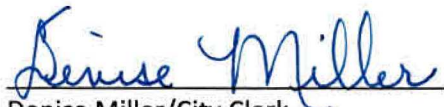
4 tax bills for 2 properties are delinquent, 2 from 2018 and 2 from 2019, and liens have been filed against both homeowners.

City Administrator Eden shared an update regarding the Rolling Ridge Sidewalk Project, due to resident non-approval, the north sidewalk from the Evergreen/Rolling Ridge Way intersection going east to HWY 1848/Buck Creek Road will be eliminated.

City Administrator Eden shared the 2018 Sewer Project funding will be available by the end of the month. Plans have been completed and are ready for submission to Division of Water. **Commissioner Hesse made the motion to authorize the Mayor to sign the Division of Water Application. Commissioner Garland seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**
