- WHEREAS,** Each year, dozens of Americans die from exposure to cold; and
- WHEREAS,** Each year, fires caused by unsafe use of heaters, vehicle accidents, and other winter weather casualties occur because of the cold and snow; and
- WHEREAS,** A major winter storm can last for several days, trapping people in cars or at home without utilities or other assistance; and
- WHEREAS,** Aftermath of a winter storm can have an impact on a community or region for days, weeks, or even months; and
- WHEREAS,** The vast majority of winter weather fatalities can be avoided with the proper preventative actions; and
- WHEREAS,** The key to understanding dangers of winter weather is through education and awareness; and
- WHEREAS,** The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Weather Service and the Kentucky Weather Preparedness Committee proclaimed December 21-25, 2012 as Winter Weather Preparedness Week in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;
